

**ASOTIN COUNTY PUD
SEWER SERVICE
RATES, CHARGES and FEES
EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2012**

SECTION I

It is hereby established for sewer services furnished by the District within its' service area, the following monthly sewer charges. Monthly Charges will be subject to a state utility tax at the current rate of 3.852% multiplied by and added to the total of all charges for services provided:

It is hereby set and established the following fees and charges:

Any business or home that uses a Septic Tank Effluent Pump System shall pay an additional monthly fee beyond the monthly charges.

Septic Tank Effluent Pump (STEP) System Fee

Any business or in-home business which by ordinance requires a grease trap or has been determined by the District to have a significant impact upon the sewer treatment system shall pay an additional monthly fee beyond the monthly charges.
