President Greg McCall presiding, the Public Utility District No. 1 of Asotin County Redistricting Plan Hearing was called to order at 5:30 p.m. at the PUD Office at 1500 Scenic Way, Clarkston, Washington.

REDISTRICTING PLAN HEARING

Open Hearing

Commissioner McCall opened the Public Hearing for the proposed Redistricting Plan at 5:30 p.m.

Manager Introduction of Proposed Redistricting Plan

The manager presented a proposed Commissioner District Boundary map, a population distribution document and legal descriptions of each District as completed by Sammamish Data Systems. He reported that the 2020 Census database was published Thursday, August 12 and redistricting began immediately. The Census showed a total population within the PUD service boundary of 19,949. As stated by RCW 29A.76.010, each Commissioner District is required to have an equal or near equal population distribution or a deviation of less than 1%. Based on the Census data, there was a 5.68% deviation in population. From the data, a Redistricting Plan was developed, District boundaries were realigned, with preference to current precincts, and population was distributed to a sub 1%. The process concluded with the development of legal descriptions of each District boundary.

Commissioner Input on Proposed Redistricting Plan

Commissioners stated that the proposed Redistricting Plan meets the requirements of state law.

Public Comment on Proposed Redistricting Plan

A registered voter in attendance stated that the proposed Redistricting Plan looks good.

Close Hearing – Adjournment

Commissioner McCall declared the Redistricting Plan Hearing closed at 5:36 p.m. and adjourned.
