

**CITY of CLARKSTON SEWER SYSTEM
SEWER SERVICE
RATES, CHARGES and FEES
EFFECTIVE APRIL 1, 2023**

The City of Clarkston and the PUD entered into a City Sewer System Operator Agreement which provides full authority to the PUD to operate the City Sewer System and authority to the PUD Board of Commissioners to adopt rates, charges and fees for City Sewer System service to the City, its residents and other users of the sewer system sufficient to maintain, operate and improve the City Sewer System.

SECTION I

It is hereby established for sewer services furnished by the PUD, within the City service area, the following Monthly Sewer Charges:

1. The Monthly Sewer Charge will be based on a two-month average of water consumed for the months of January and February of the previous year.
2. Total Monthly Charges include a state utility tax at the current rate of 3.852%.
3. Green houses and accounts not connected to the PUD water system will be billed at the Monthly Base Charge plus the Average Monthly Water Consumption for their Classification. The average monthly residential water consumption is 6.45 units and the average commercial water consumption is 10 units.
4. Automatic car washes will be charged three (3) times the Commercial Average Monthly Rate.

SECTION II

SEWER CONNECTION FEES

A Sewer Connection Fee will be assessed for each dwelling or commercial building that will be connected to the City Sewer System and a System Development Fee will also be assessed per Equivalent Residential Unit (ERU) as identified in the User Classification Schedule.

Any commercial, industrial, residential or multi-family dwelling that requests sewer service shall pay the following fees in order to connect the City Sewer System:

* After work hours is defined as the time before 7:00 am and after 4:30 pm Monday through Friday on regularly scheduled work days. Holidays and weekends will be considered as "after work hours."
