<u>Water System Activity</u> – Specialty Pump completed the pulling of Well No. 7 components and discovered that two rings, that holds the shaft in place, broke apart and dropped into the pump. A video of the well was completed and the well looks good. The cost of replacing the pump, column, shaft and rings will be provided before the next Board meeting.

<u>Sewer System Activity</u> – The Wastewater Treatment Plant screw press has been repaired and is operational. Staff are continuing the videoing of the sewer collection system for the Comprehensive Sewer Plan and are near completion on the shed covering for the grit removal building.

COMMISSIONER'S REPORT

Commissioner Ridge virtually attended a Washington PUD Association (WPUDA) Budget Committee meeting on October 17. She reported that the WPUDA 2025 Budget includes a 6% increase in dues. The committee discussed the issues and improvements the WPUDA office building needs and how these updates will be financed. The final budget will be presented to the full board and Executive Committee at the WPUDA meeting in November.

Commissioner Ridge will be attending the Public Power Council Annual Meeting in Portland, Oregon November 5-7.

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Commissioner McCall will be attending an Energy Northwest Board of Directors meeting and Public Power Forum October 23-25 in Kennewick, Washington.

Commissioner Nuxoll will be virtually attending the Public Utility Risk Management System meetings November 6-7.
