This Bid will remain subject to acceptance for fortyfive (45) days after the day of Bid opening. BIDDER will sign and deliver the required number of counterparts of the Agreement with the Bonds and other documents required by the Bidding Requirements within ten (10) days after the date of OWNER's Notice of Award.

- (b) BIDDER has visited the site, conducted a thorough visual examination of the Site and adjacent areas, and become familiar with the general, local and site conditions that may affect cost, progress, performance and furnishing of the Work;
- (c) BIDDER is familiar with all federal, state and local Laws and Regulations that may affect cost, progress, performance and furnishing of the Work.

- BIDDER has carefully studied all reports of explorations and tests of (d) subsurface conditions at or contiguous to the site and all drawings of physical conditions in or relating to existing surface or subsurface structures at or contiguous to the site (except Underground Facilities) which have been identified in the Supplementary General Conditions as provided in paragraph 5.03.A of the General Conditions. BIDDER acknowledges that such reports and drawings are not Contract Documents and may not be complete for BIDDER'S purposes. BIDDER acknowledges that OWNER and ENGINEER do not assume responsibility for the accuracy or completeness of information and data shown or indicated in the Contract Documents with respect to Underground Facilities at or contiguous to the site.
- BIDDER has obtained and carefully studied (or assumes responsibility for (e) having done so) all additional or supplementary examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies and data concerning conditions (surface, subsurface and Underground Facilities) at or contiguous to the Site which may affect cost, progress, or performance of the Work or which relate to any aspect of the means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction to be employed by BIDDER, including applying the specific means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction expressly required by the Bidding Documents to be employed by BIDDER, and safety precautions and programs incident thereto.
- BIDDER has carefully studied the reports and drawings relating to Hazardous (f) Environmental Conditions, if any, at or adjacent to the Site that have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions, with respect to Technical Data in such reports and drawings.
- BIDDER does not consider that any additional examinations, investigations, (g) explorations, tests, studies or data are necessary for the determination of this Bid for performance and furnishing of the Work in accordance with the times, price and other terms and conditions of the Contract Documents.
- BIDDER is aware of the general nature of Work to be performed by OWNER (h) and others at the site that relates to Work for which this Bid is submitted as indicated in the Bidding Documents.
- (i) BIDDER has correlated the information known to BIDDER, information and observations obtained from visits to the site, reports and drawings identified in the Contract Documents and all additional examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies and data with the Contract Documents.
- BIDDER has given OWNER written notice of all conflicts, errors, ambiguities (j) or discrepancies that BIDDER has discovered in the Bidding Documents and the written resolution thereof by OWNER is acceptable to BIDDER, and the

- Bidding Documents are generally sufficient to indicate and convey understanding of all terms and conditions for performing and furnishing the Work for which this Bid is submitted.
- (k) This Bid is genuine and not made in the interest of or on behalf of any undisclosed person, firm or corporation and is not submitted in conformity with any agreement or rules of any group, association, organization or corporation; BIDDER has not directly or indirectly induced or solicited any other BIDDER to submit a false or sham Bid; BIDDER has not solicited or induced any person, firm or corporation to refrain from bidding; and BIDDER has not sought by collusion to obtain for itself any advantage over any other BIDDER or over OWNER.
- (1) BIDDER agrees to be bound by and will comply with and further agrees that the provisions required by RCW 39.12 and 40 U.S.C. 276(a) pertaining to prevailing wage rates, as applicable, shall be included in this contract. In addition, the undersigned Bidder hereby certifies that, within the three-year period immediately preceding the bid solicitation date for this Project, the bidder is not a "willful" violator, as defined in RCW 49.48.082, of any provision of chapters 49.46, 49.48, or 49.52 RCW, as determined by a final and binding citation and notice of assessment issued by the Department of Labor and Industries or through a civil judgment entered by a court of limited or general jurisdiction
- BIDDER agrees that if awarded the contract, the BIDDER will complete the (m) Work within the time limits specified in the Agreement.
- (n) The Contract Documents are generally sufficient to indicate and convey understanding of all terms and conditions for performance and furnishing of the Work.
- (o) The submission of this Bid constitutes an incontrovertible representation by BIDDER that without exception the Bid and all prices in the Bid are premised upon performing and furnishing the Work required by the Bidding Documents.
